RE: **2017 SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

Dear Plan Participants and Beneficiaries:

This is a summary of the Annual Report for the Michiana Area Electrical Workers' Money Purchase Plan, Employer Identification Number 35-1861971, Plan No. 001, for the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. The Annual Report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Benefits under the Plan are provided by a trust. Plan Expenses were \$1,956,425. These Expenses included \$99,436 in Administrative Expenses (*see Schedule A*) and \$1,856,989 in benefits paid to Participants and Beneficiaries. A total of 1,720 Participants and Beneficiaries had an account balance at the end of the Plan Year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of Plan Assets, after subtracting Liabilities of the Plan, was \$71,984,458 as of December 31, 2017, compared to \$61,718,225 as of January 1, 2017. During the Plan Year the Plan experienced an increase in its Net Assets of \$10,266,233. This increase includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of Plan Assets; that is, the difference between the value of the Plan Assets at the end of the year and the value of the Assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of Assets acquired during the year. During the current Plan Year, the Plan had Total Income of \$12,222,658, including Employer Contributions of \$5,205,054, earnings from Investments of \$7,011,495 and other Income of \$6,109.

MINIMUM FUNDING STANDARDS

Enough money was contributed to the Plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.

You have the right to receive a copy of the full Annual Report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in that report;

1. An Accountant's report;
2. Financial information and information on payments to service providers;
3. Assets held for investment; and
4. Information regarding any common or collective trusts, pooled separate accounts, master trust or 103-12 investment entities in which the Plan participates.

If you request a copy of the full Annual Report from the Plan Administrative Manager, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that Report.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the Annual Report at the main office of the Plan (Michiana Area Electrical Workers Money Purchase Plan), 6525 Centurion Drive; Lansing, MI 48917-9275), at any other location where the Report is available for examination and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
